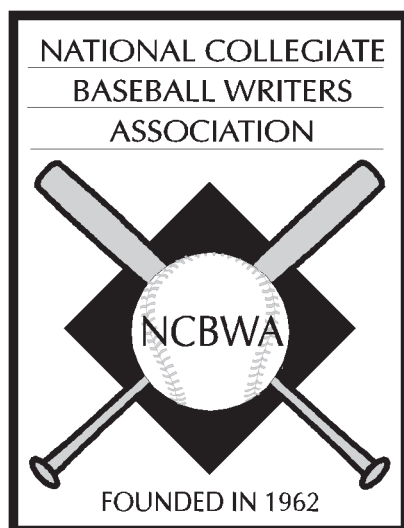

THE WILBUR SNYPP AWARD

There have been 35 recipients of the award, which is presented annually in memory of longtime Ohio State Sports Information Director and NCBWA founder, the late Wilbur (Bill) Snynn. Snynn was a noted contributor to the writers' organization, which was initiated in 1962, as well as an officer in the group.

The NCBWA/Wilbur Snynn Award yearly honors a professional for his/her contributions to the sport of collegiate baseball. Voting is done by a panel of previous winners, who include past NCAA World Series directors, College Sports Information Directors of America Hall of Fame members, decorated media members and many others.
