

The National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association named Johns Hopkins University centerfielder Dave Kahn (Sr. Hyde Park, N.Y.) its 2010 NCAA Division III "Position Player of the Year" on June 4 and Chapman University's Brian Rauh (Fr., Lake Forest, Calif.) its "Pitcher of the Year." Kahn, a unanimous pick of the eight NCAA Division III sports information directors, was named American Baseball Coaches Association and "D3baseball.com" first-team All-America and the Centennial Conference "Position Player of the Year" with a .458 batting average, 73 runs scored, 16 doubles, five triples, 16 home runs, 71 RBI, an .872 slugging percentage, a .512 on-base percentage and 18 stolen bases. Rauh, who picked up four-of-eight first-place votes, earned ABCA and "D3baseball.com" first-team All-America honors with a 10-0 record, a 2.42 earned run average, 10.78 strikeouts per nine innings, 2.42 walks per nine innings and a .176 opponent batting average.
